The paper does not seem to possess the qualities of a well-structured, robust research paper and needs substantial changes on the following bases:

1. A more comprehensive abstract and introduction is needed.
2. The review of the literature section is too brief. Reference to previous studies is a requirement for a sound research paper. The gap in the literature and the purpose of the study have not been elaborated adequately.
3. Information about the methodology is inadequate. A more detailed description of the research participants, research instrument(s), data collection and analysis procedures is demanded. Particularly, the instrument section seems not to include a description of the instrument employed but an insertion of the survey items into this section.
4. The findings need to be visualized via tabulation, using charts, or other techniques to facilitate their comprehensibility.
5. The discussion and conclusion sections including the implications of the study need expansion.
6. Greater number of references are required to boost the rigor of the study.
