The article addresses a very important need for blind people. It is, however, not clear if blind people were involved in the experiments. I therefore recommend that the experiment be repeated with blind people, some of them using a normal stick and others using the smart stick. Then they must compare the results of the smart stick with those of the normal stick in terms of how the smart stick enhances the movement of blind people. They must also indicate if the smart stick improves the walking speed of blind people.
