- -It is important to state in the methodology section, the kind of estimation technique employed in the regression analysis and its justification
- -Few sentences do not read well and need clarity, for instance.. "fixed effects models (FEM) and random effects models (REM) to robustly the OLS regression results and give more valid results"

Again, "....with a regression coefficient of (β = 0.0483), has a positive and statistically significant...". I recommend a thorough proofreading of the article

-In discussing the results, the authors make mention of the "financial performance of commercial banks", the study however is investigating the performance of insurance firms. The necessary corrections need to be done

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
