## Few observations:

- 1. It is not clear if Arora is the only author. What is the role of the remaining 2 names, Pandya C. and Mathur F.?
- 2. Proofreading is needed to remove the numerous typos: missing spaces, unneeded capital letters, missing punctuation, subscript numbers.
- 3. The authors should eliminate repetitions and redundancies: i.e., in the abstract or in the first paragraph.
- 4. Ganoderma should be written in italics in the title.
- 5. Pictures and images are needed to improve the graphic side of the manuscript.
- 6. A reduced interconnection was perceived between the different sections of the manuscript.
