Thank you for the interesting journal article, which is important as it seeks to use renewable materials. I have the following comments.

- 1. There are statements that require referencing in the introduction section. The number of references in the article is not sufficient. To avoid plagiarism, you need to reference where appropriate; this has to be done.
- 2. Avoid the use of terms such as etc. in the introduction section; you can rephrase this.
- 3. There is a need for a running grammar and spell check on the article.
- 4. Why did you select the experimental design that you did? How did you arrive at the ratios you chose, and why not other ratios? Would it not have been much better to use an experimental design covering a wide range of volume fractions?
- 5. There is Figure 7, which is hazy and needs to be fixed.
- 6. The results need to be discussed and analyzed, not only presented in tabular form or graph, and relate this to the literature. A critical analysis is needed.
- 7. There is a mix-up of methodology and results. The methodology is repeated again in the results and discussion. This needs to be sorted out.

In conclusion, the article contributes to the body of knowledge; however, the areas highlighted above need to be addressed. I recommend minor revisions and acceptance of the article.

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
