Introduction: The introduction is well-organized and coherent;

Abstract: It is well-written.

Methods: It is clear and addresses the flow of the procedures;

Results and discussion: In this case, the results are clearly written and scientifically organized.

Conclusion: It is okay, but clearly identify the two strain waves, 1 and 2, in line with the suggested assumptions.

References: It would be better if recent citations were included, such as works from 2023-2025, for instance; <https://doi.org/10.1038/s41598-023-42334-4>

Check the typos, grammar, and spelling, as there are some errors in the introduction and abstract.

Generally, the paper is very informative and well-written, addressing the title. The abstract is also well-written, composing its elements. The overall document is well-organized and addresses its intention in relating every subsection.
