The contribution is very interesting and well organized. It presents a framework relating to the relevance of the enactive approach on the value of cognitive processes, in terms of co-determination of the subjective and intersubjective meaning of the action, which impact on the transformation of social reality and which affect dynamic historical visions.

The procedural perspective of configurations and reconfigurations, as a circular movement of the meanings attributed in action by situated context, highlights the value of the cognitive circumstances expressed in action in terms of transformative historical impact. This vision goes beyond the exclusive constructivist approach of the social sciences, to travel a look at the centrality of perception situated in acted-out experientiality, as a transformative ontological process of mediation between cognition and signification situated in relation, which highlight the interdependent codetermination of action, reality, context, but also the overlapping by degrees and interconnected levels of perceived realities, which frame social reality in a historical-cognitive perspective.
