

Review of: "Factors contributing to labour unrest at the garment factories in Bangladesh: A cross-sectional study"

This article is an interesting article, but need some revisions for better understanding.

The introduction and literature review is very long and could be summarized and customized in little words.

The sample size calculation for this works could be estimated based on the sample size formula for correlation coefficients/ OR/ two proportion. But the authors used the formula for one proportion. Is the objective of this study was estimation of prevalence/proportion of labour unrest? Or the main outcome is the related factors of labour unrest? However, the sample size is enough for powerful study to find relationship and related factors.

How the seventeen items were subdivided into 4 subscales? Did it based on factor analysis? or the sum of scores of each items in each subscale calculated?

The estimation and calculation the labour unrest did not describe in method. How the primary outcome is measured? is labour unrest is a continues variable or dichotomous? it need to describe the outcome variable better.

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
