This study performs an analysis to understand which drug is most appropriate in patients with multiple bone metastases. As the article points out, since there are no studies to directly compare different antiresorptive agents. Therefore, the authors of the study conducted an analysis based on drug costs, logistics and facilities, patients' preferences, renal toxicity, and expected risk of Medication-Related Osteonecrosis of the Jaw (MRONJ) and the timing of administration in order to define a personalized treatment for each patient.
