- 1. Authors should identify which Cinnamomum species tested in the present study, such as the other species.
- 2. In the introduction section, I disagree with repeating the same citation (Ventola, 2015) in all written sentences.
- 3. The brief on the "History of Antibiotic Resistance" is completely insufficient to review previously published literature. You should add more details and different antibiotic-resistant strains.
- 4. Same as I illustrated above, I disagree with using repeating the same citations (Ventola, 2015) and (Aslam et al., 2018) in all written sentences in section (1.2. Factors Contributing to Antibiotic Resistance). Did the authors not find other references to confirm their words?
- 5. Write the abbreviated names of the bacterial species after their first appearance in the text.
- 6. Information given in section (1.4. Herbal Treatment for Antibiotic-Resistant Bacteria) should be supported with appropriate references related to the cited text.
- 7. Methods: I suggest using the full name of Cinnamomum species, as you illustrated in Table 1.
- 8. Conclusions: Add a summary of the potential efficacy of the tested herbal material.
- 9. References: Latin names should be written in italics.
