Recommendations for review

1/In the introduction, the last paragraph requires more precision, for a good understanding of the context of your work.

2/ It is important to add references in your manuscript, particularly in the results and discussion section. I recommend as an example:

- 3/ Your results have not been well discussed; To enrich your discussion, I recommend that you study the electronic effect of substituted groups.
- 4/ Schiff bases have the property of chelating metal ions; it is therefore preferable that the products prepared are metal complexes rather than metal salts and its proposed molecular structure.
- 5/ Why do the authors not use another standard antibiotic to compare the results of the antibacterial activity tests.
- 6/ The conclusion must be clear and precise; try to rewrite your conclusion in the form of points to conclude your study.
- 7/ Lack of certain analytical data on the products obtained, such as colors and melting points.
- 8/ It is very interesting to study the possibility of carrying out UV-visible electronic spectroscopy analysis.
