Literature Review

The content details are not based on any research objectives.

What is the definition of the key concepts linked to this research?

There is some research acknowledged, but there is a need to address the question: How is this related to your research?

What theoretical framework is developed? The Algorithmic Thinking Theory (ATT, or Algorithm Framework Theory, AFT; Li, 2009-2023), is mentioned. There is a need to explain it, analyse it, and then apply it to create the necessary criticality in your discussion.

What research gaps emerge?

What is the research methodology, and how is it developed, justified, and applied? This article seems to focus on

secondary data. Discuss this.

The Findings

What data is generated, and how is it critically analysed? The literature review you have developed can be used to strengthen your analysis of the findings, including the theoretical framework.

There needs to be created a synthesis and evaluation of your discussion.

Conclusion

The conclusion is delivered based on your objectives and the evidence from your findings. Any further recommendations going forward?

There is therefore the need to create a much stronger structure for a research article.

Suggestions:

- Refine the abstract and make it much more informative.
- Further develop your introduction and focus on your problem statement and desired output. What are your objectives? What do you intend to accomplish and deliver in this article?
- Create a section to provide an understanding and justification of the issues at stake and where they are coming from.
- The literature review is what this article is focusing on. How is this linked to the research at stake?
- Create a research methodology and generate how the data to be applied in the article is delivered.
- Create a data collection presentation and then make a critical analysis of the data based on the literature review session, which is good.
- Provide a more research-focused conclusion and create some recommendations for future research.
