

Review of: "Grammatical Aspects of Feminatives Through the Ukrainian Prism"

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The manuscript addresses an important topic at the intersection of language and gender. However, the text raises several concerns that should be addressed by the author before the publication:

1. The manuscript lacks a methodology section. The introduction is followed directly by results and discussion. "To be specific, we will analyze the feminine set given in (Плачинда 2018)" - How was the analysis conducted? "According to the statistical method" - Which method was used?
2. The author treats language as a stable, self-governing entity. But what can you say about the role of power relations in shaping languages? Which social groups possess authority to decide what is considered grammatically correct? How do languages respond to social change, including the demand for gender equality?
3. Non-binary people seem to be instrumentalized for the purposes of supporting the author's argumentation. What is the opinion of non-binary individuals themselves about the proposed language reforms? Please, engage with the literature.
