The paper constitutes substantial research. However, some issues should be addressed:

- 1. The Abstract should focus on the research objectives and findings. An excessive description of the method is not necessary. The method can be fully described in the "Method" section.
- 2. The "Introduction" and "Literature Review" parts should focus on gamification. An excessive description of the learning types doesn't add anything to the research potential.
- 3. The Kiili's empirical model should be described in the "Literature review" section. It can only be used as a reference to the authors' method. The research methodology should be centered on the authors' framework, describing the requisite processes.
- 4. The questions that the variables reflect are not described. Even a rough description of the questions could contribute to a better comprehension of the questionnaire.
- 5. The contribution of the study to gamification should be accentuated in the "Introduction" section.
- 6. English proofreading is necessary.

I think that the improvements mentioned above could level this paper up.
