This is an interesting paper but parts could be developed in a more convincing manner. For instance, the individual with autism as a criminal section is not well-developed. The phrase "There have been a lot of cases of individuals with Autism offending the US Criminal Justice System" is vague and the only one with any form of citation in this short section. Is this lots, statistically significant relative to the neurotypical population? Surely, the vulnerability of those neurodiverse individuals is the bigger issue, especially in cities that can be overwhelming and disorientating, increasing their vulnerability. This general point of greater incorporation of academic citation is something that I would recommend for some of the earlier sections.
