The study "Unlocking Natural Capital in the Megadiverse Colombian Pacific Basin: Navigating Challenges and Governance Gaps" is interesting in terms of the economic evaluation it makes of ecosystem services; however, the authors must work on at least three aspects of the results:

- 1. The authors comment on the monetary variability present in the studies included for analysis. In this regard, it is not indicated whether this variability is due to the diversity of methods used in each of the ecosystem services evaluated. The authors should include tables by ecosystem services, indicating the monetary estimate, type and number of studies by valuation method included.
- 2. Discussion about how valid the estimate is given the methods used.
- 3. Tables are mentioned in the results but are not included. The inclusion of values which cannot be verified by the reviewer reduces the credibility of the results obtained.
