The Manuscript requires major revision. The following points should be addressed in the revised manuscript:

1. The abstract is poorly written. Reframe the abstract by using scientific language.
2. State the rationale behind the presented work, including the points of novelty.
3. The authors have prepared only one ligand; why?
4. On the basis of docking only, antitubercular activity cannot be predicted. I suggest including the in vitro/in vivo pharmacological activity against the same.
5. Which software was used for molecular docking?
6. On the basis of a single molecule, SAR cannot be predicted.
7. The language is very poor throughout the manuscript; it should be revised carefully.
