Dear authors,

First of all, I would like to congratulate you on the results obtained and the clarity of your presentation. Next, I would like to make some proposals for improvement. With regard to the scientific literature used, it would be advisable to update it, and they should all be included in the bibliography, and in the same way, those described in this section should be cited in the text. In this sense, it is proposed to unify the citations throughout the text. The figures included are explanatory, but it would be advisable to review their legibility and include the sources of elaboration at the foot of the figures.

With regard to the methodology, although it is clear, it would be useful to justify the choice of the software used in order to clarify for the reader. Point out those studies that have been mentioned as having been used to elaborate the questions in the survey. In this line, it would be very beneficial to provide more data on the members of the sample (gender, studies undertaken, etc.) There is no discussion section in the conclusions, so it is proposed to include it and to go into this aspect in greater depth in order to give greater weight to the results obtained in the research. Finally, the use of repeated words should be reviewed and synonyms proposed.

Despite the suggestions made, I would like to highlight the work they have done on the use of gamification and e-learning in teaching-learning processes. A work that opens up future lines of research.
