Review of: "Genetic and Environmental Influences on Awassi Lamb Weights with Implications for Breeding and Management in Jordan"

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The article is relevant, well-written, and effectively contextualizes the results with clear interpretation and practical application. The revised version of the manuscript shows significant improvement and, in my opinion, is ready for publication. I would only suggest two minor adjustments to further enhance the clarity and structure of the text:

Methodology – definition of “Controlled Suckling”: Providing a definition of Controlled Suckling may be important for readers to understand the specific methodology used for suckling management, as different production systems may apply varying protocols.

Section 2.1 – Materials and Methods: The first paragraph of this section, while relevant, does not strictly pertain to the methodological content and may be more appropriately placed in the Introduction or Discussion, where it can contribute to the contextual background of the study.
