However, improvements are needed: Clarify the methodology and better define the entry and exit criteria. Include quantitative analysis - a meta-analysis/statistics strengthens the conclusions. Check for confounding factors - consider genetics, medications, and lifestyle. Provide a stronger connection between the element and the rock curve c. Discuss potential risks - cover concerns about excess vitamin D/Mg toxicity. Ensure transparency - include a conflict of interest statement.
