Behaviour Change Intervention Ontology (BCIO)

Definition: A communication involving the exchange of light and teasing remarks intended to be playful.

Comment: Note that teasing is an essential part of the definition of banter. For amusing or enjoyable communication, but without the element of teasing, using entertaining or humourous communication style. Also, note that banter may not always be perceived as playful by the subject of the remarks

Ontological definitions can sometimes be hard to read. In those cases we also include an informal definition.

Definitions also often require elaboration to make it clear how they should be used and what they include. In those cases we include a comment.

Also, definitions sometimes require an explanation as to how they came about to help users understand how they relate to alternative definitions. In those cases we include a curator note.
