# Review of: "Management of Choledochal Cyst of Cystic Duct in Adult: A Very Rare Case Report"

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While the radiological images are of good quality and contribute to the understanding of the case, the laparoscopic intraoperative image lacks clarity and educational value. It is recommended to either replace it with a more illustrative image or provide a more detailed description to contextualize its relevance.

The surgical procedure is described in overly general terms. A more comprehensive narrative is encouraged, including:

- Specific details of the laparoscopic technique employed;
- Any intraoperative challenges encountered due to the choledochal cyst (e.g., adhesions, anatomical distortion, limited visibility, etc.);
- The exact dimensions of the cyst, which are clinically relevant and should be clearly stated.

The use of brand names for medications should be avoided.
