Review of: "Creating a Child-Centered Playroom for Marshallese Children"

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The authors did a great job of providing the historical context and situations of Marshallese children in the United States. The approaches of child-centered therapies and how they might apply to this community were well explored. Their approaches and recommendations for creating culturally appropriate playrooms are also valuable. These recommendations mainly focus on items within the playroom. I think it would be good to know more about the room itself, such as recommendations for size, indoor/outdoor spaces or features, artwork, access to daylight, etc., as well. As a commentary paper, this is a great starting point. Their call for future research can explore these playrooms in more depth.
