

Review of: "Lived Experience of School Leaders in Supervising during Remote Teaching"

Overall, this was a relevant topic. However, I feel the design of the study and the clarity of the manuscript can be improved.

Methodology:

- The author seems to use principals and teachers interchangeably since it was initially mentioned that 20 public school principals were selected but later, it was said that "Upon their written approval, the teachers' narratives were gathered". As these terms have different meanings in the context of this article, this made methodology confusing.
- There is no detailed description of how the coding process was conducted. Since the study is conducted by a single person, there could be bias in the coding process.

Findings and discussion:

- Some of the themes seem to have been mentioned by only 1 participant, which makes reader wonder if these are commonalities that are truly shared among all of the participants.
- Only a handful of participants were included in the themes identified. Unclear regarding any content for the interviews with the other participants.
