In general, it is a well-written article on a highly topical topic. The design of the survey and the objectives set are coherent and the methodology correct. It presents some problems that it refers to below:

In the Material and Methods section, it says that the survey design was based on the literature, but does not cite any study that supports this statement.

Question 1 of Table 2 also presents a p value of 0.0011, so it should be included in the discussion.

When qualitative variables with multiple categories are compared, in addition to the global X<sup>2</sup> test, pairwise comparisons must be made to detect between which specific categories the significant differences occur, in this way it can be specified how the two compared groups differ.
