- 1. Check and correct typographical errors.
- 2. Authors omitted citations for some key articles reviewed in this work.
- 3. How was treatment responses in the patients evaluated in the case studies described? For instance the oxygen levels, x-rays reported, include lab images, tables, etc that were used for evaluations. These are some ways to further authenticate these studies and begin to disseminate the evidences required to support plant-based remedies.
