The study "Facility Management Challenges of Public Educational Facilities in Nigeria" is critical for enhancing the management of constructed facilities. However, the authors need to address the following major concerns:

- 1. The topic indicates the study is about general challenges of FM, but the paper focuses only on maintenance. I wonder if the authors will reconcile this difference by adjusting the title or updating the literature.
- 2. The paper reports a critical study reflecting a substantial effort; however, the article lacks a clear and structured approach to address this fascinating topic.
- 3. The research methodology is too shallow; the data collection and analysis methods should be justified. It might be helpful to have a flowchart or diagram outlining every stage of the study.
- 4. Several organizations are responsible for funding education in Nigeria apart from TETfund, e.g., State Governments, PTDF, etc. Please justify the reason for relying solely on TEfund.
- 5. The authors have presented several results without substantiating the possible reasons for obtaining such outcomes. It would be helpful if the authors could infer the possible reasons for this outcome.
- 6. The researchers did not outline their procedures to avoid potential mistakes during the data collection or analysis phases. Please describe the steps taken to guarantee that errors are reduced.
- 7. The discussion of the results is shallow and unrelated to the existing literature. Please update the discussion section and relates the findings to the literature.

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
