The diagnosis is very, very difficult, and the differential diagnosis is important. The disease is often on the skin; however, there are known cases of hematogenous spread of the disease.

In diagnosis, microbiological and histopathological studies are important. The choice of treatment method depends on the type of pathogen, location, extent, and depth of the disease process. Actinomycetoma usually responds well to treatment, while treatment for eumycetoma may be ineffective.

I found a few small mistakes, e.g., after the sentence: "These opportunistic pathogens depend on mechanical disruption of normal barriers by disease, or trauma[90]," Please change the reference style.
