Good paper and has addressed a critical area. Relatively high rates of hypertension control (in comparison to many LMIC settings where it is around 20%) indicate that the service delivery is good.

There should be more information on government support and specific recommendations on how to contain costs of medicines, investigations, etc. Longer refills, step-down care in the community, digital connectivity to help patients self-care, etc., are options to be addressed. Implementation research can identify which of these can work and can be scaled up.

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
