In the introduction, the authors could refer to the lockdown due to COVID-19 because this imposed the exploitation of IT concepts in the domain of education. There should be argumentation on how the time frame 2015 – 2023 was selected. The authors write "--- approaches that are reshaping the industry" — which industry? There is a need for specification. The article is related to general information technology. The authors should have clarified what is meant by "tertiary institutions" — are they the only ones? And also, the authors should clarify why the article mentions Nigeria as a kind of case study, while the discussion of IoT, etc., and its impact on learning is an international and broader one.

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
