

Review of: "A Bibliometric Review of CSR in China Based on CNKI Database: 2006-2022"

This manuscript has an interesting title which is commendable and timely. However, there is still room for improvement.

In terms of abstract, the problem statement or issue why this study needs to be done is not clear. There is no correlation between the first two statements and the research objective in the third sentence. For the research methodology, the authors should state the analysis tools used for the bibliometric analysis. Research finding/s should be included in the abstract as well.

There are many abbreviations without full terms being explained for example CNKI, CSSCI, SEC, ISSB. All these abbreviations must be provided with their full terms to make it understandable especially for the readers who are not familiar with them.

There are a few paragraphs that are not cited with any citations for example on page 2, 3 and 4.

In the research methodology section, the authors should justify why China Knowledge Network has been used to get the data and why CiteSpace software being used in the bibliometric analysis. Did not support it with previous studies that have employed the same tool or software.

I could not see the relationship between research objective, research analysis, research findings and the conclusion. In my opinion, authors should have a clear explanation between all the four items above to show the coherence and cohesion between them.

The references for the study are very limited which is only eight sources. This number is far from sufficient. As such, the authors should include more citations and references to enhance the robustness of the arguments.
