Recommendations:

- In the methodology section, the author did not specify the diagnostic criteria when diagnosing varicocele with DUS.
 Please indicate the pathological limits of the diameters of the veins seen on ultrasound so that they can be identified as varicoceles.
- 2. In the discussion section, it would have been a more comprehensive article if the author had made a reference not only to how effective DUS is, but also to its financial burden.

Conclusion:

Although it is generally a well-written article, its contribution to the medical literature is questionable.
