For example, instead of writing "In this paper, we aim to identify," it is better to write "This paper aims to identify," and instead of "In addition, as well as getting expert opinions on these new learning tools, we have launched open questions on ResearchGate," it is better to write "In addition, as well as getting expert opinions on these new learning tools, the open questions have been launched on ResearchGate."
