The submitted manuscript titled "Factors Associated With Hospitalization Outcomes for Cases of Anemia in Pregnancy at a Regional Level in Burkina Faso" needs to be rejected due to several issues:

- 1. The data submitted by the authors pertains to the years 2009-2011, making it approximately 13 years old. Given that it is now 2024, various factors affecting hospitalization outcomes for cases of anemia in pregnancy within the study area may have undergone significant changes. For example, interventions introduced by NGOs or the government in the interim years could have substantially addressed the issue.
- 2. A recommendation is for the authors to conduct a fresh study, comparing the previous data with more recent information. This updated dataset has the potential to be published, providing valuable insights into the evolving landscape of anemia in pregnancy outcomes.
- 3. The literature review also requires updating as the references used are outdated, with the most recent ones dating back to 2021.
- 4. There is room for improvement in the conclusion of the study.
