I really enjoyed reading the paper. It is well written and organized. It makes an important statement by addressing the limitations of institutional approaches to commons and nature through critical realism. In my account, this is the main contribution of the paper, considering the influence of Ostrom in the debates, including among Latin American scholars. In this sense, my only suggestion would be to further elaborate the theoretical implications of the findings, in order to advance the critique of common pool resources as an approach that informs governance arrangements that allow the reproduction of ecosystem services inequality.
