Please review the title and the introduction as it reflects some anthropological biases. Your "God" is implicitly conceived as the catholic god (given as equivalent of Jesus), and this is very selective. You don't cover all forms of gods or divinities.

This religious selection should be explained. Maybe the rationale is already in Long & Perry, but this is not sufficiently detailed.

The analysis of the 69 reports of year 2022 is not totally justified.

In the interpretation of the results, the characteristics can perhaps be interpreted as more "experiential" qualities of god, in comparison with its theoretical qualities (omniscience, omnipresence...).
