Dear author, the topic covered is very interesting and well contextualized but there is no analysis of the state of the art at an international level (for example: Corpo Nazionale Soccorso Alpino e Speleologico <https://www.cnsas.it/>; Secours en montagne PGHM 06 http://www.secours-montagne06.com/preface_038.htm; Grupos de Rescate Especial de Intervención en Montaña (GREIM) <https://www.guardiacivil.es/es/institucional/Conocenos/especialidades/Greim/index.html>; Commission of Alpine Rescue (ICAR-CISA) <https://www.alpine-rescue.org>) that would allow for a more precise picture of the best practices adopted in mountain rescue activities.

Their knowledge would help in defining the possible paths of professional training and organization of the same.

The bibliographic references are dated and it is advisable to include more recent references as well.
