

Review of: "Building Design Parameters for the Safety of Individuals with Autism Spectrum Disorder"

First of all, I appreciate the opportunity to review this writing, the subject matter of which is interesting. However, at times I have been a bit thrown off by the organization of the writing. For example, I find a disconnect between the title and the keywords. Another, figure 1 is not clear to me, what does it reflect?

Perhaps the authors should go deeper into the relationship between crime and ASD, to improve the understanding of their proposal, which, if I have understood correctly, is the commitment to create safe public spaces so that people with ASD can function autonomously without falling into the manifestation of behavioral problems or social inadequacies. There are some sections that, as they stand, are confusing with the idea of the manuscript (for example, point 3.)

Likewise, it would be convenient to clarify the relationship of the topic with ASD, since the spectrum is very broad and is not related in the same way in the whole spectrum, and not only at a cognitive or functional level, but also at a developmental and life stage level.
