This study is a case report in which the authors proposed the use of photobiomodulation in a patient with Parkinson's disease to improve sleep disorders. I believe some adjustments are required for the article to be published. Firstly, in the Abstract section, the Conclusion should not be so assertive, seeing as only one patient was tended to and assessed during the study. The authors should be more realistic about the lack of evidence, suggesting new studies on the topic as well. Secondly, in the Methods section, the picture of the participant should not be shown so clearly. Maybe the authors should cover or blur her eyes so she is not so easily identifiable. Most importantly, the authors do not explain how the laser parameters were chosen. Were they based on any previous studies or calculations due to similar conditions? Although the text is clear and well-written, the factors mentioned above need to be better explained and reviewed.
