

Review of: "Redefining borders in the contested territory between San Pedro and San Andres Cholula"

The document is interesting from the perspective of the problem of growth and development of two localities that belong to one of the most dynamic regions of the State of Puebla; and that for several decades, they have exhibited territorial problems of influence across borders.

However, the document lacks depth in the background section; discussion and in the cartography it presents.

The background is incomplete, has mistakes, an example of which is when the author talks about the development of the automotive industry in the nineties; when the Volkswagen industry arrived in that territory in the mid-1960s; a company that has changed the environment and territorial dynamics since then. It also omits the creation of a university that also generated drastic changes since the 1940s; and that today continues to influence territorial migration processes.

On the other hand, the historical background to which the author refers lacks bibliographical references.

Regardless of what is described, the article has two major structural problems; lacks a robust methodology that demonstrates scientific rigor for conducting the study; and secondly: cartography.

What the author presents as cartography are only general figures, but in no case are they maps; because they lack the indispensable cartographic elements and criteria; This is grounds for the immediate rejection of the text.
