- 3. There must be a study background and research gap in Introduction section. Mention those.
- 4. If there is research questions linked with the objectives, mention the research questions also.
- 5. Include recent data/statistics of the stud area in the Methodology section on the issue discussed here.
- 6. There is a much more discussion on CPTED data collection method than CPTED data analysis with hot and cold spot. Explain the analysis in methodology section with proper citations.
- 7. Maps (Figure 1a,1b,3&4) must be rebuilt with proper latitude, longitude, scale and legends.
- 8. Results of perception survey should be elaborated.
- 9. You must emphasize the the discussion and conclusion section. These are not a true reflection of the analysis and results.
- 10. Check and verify the references linked with the each and every citations.
