 of bacteria: A Literature Review" is concerned it looks very lengthy I therefore suggests to shortened the title with
 modification such as "The antibacterial efficacy of some highly medicinal plants against various antibiotic resistant strains of bacteria: A Literature Review from the Qeios.
- The Abstract is well written however it needs some points to the audience such as; the short comes, solutions and future directions. _
- The author needs to avoid single source for introduction section such as Ventola, 2015.
- The source (reference) must be mentioned while providing information of traditional use of Botanicals in table 1.
- · Biological names are italicized such as most of the bacterial names even in the headings.
- Avoid irrelevant information of the bacterial resistance in the description. As some results of the previous studies have been also given. In my opinion the author should focus the main theme rather than giving all the information of the previous work done.
- The author needs to provide mechanism of action of the botanicals and essential oils.
- It is appropriate to provide a table for all the studied bacterial strain with the heading such as;

• Section 7 is advised to provide in the introduction section.



• The article needs overall look for typos errors and grammatical mistakes.
