Data Analysis: Expanding the data analysis section to include a discussion on the assumptions of the regression analysis, how they were tested, and the implications of the findings in relation to motivational theories could provide more insight.

Implications for Practice: The implications section could be strengthened by offering more concrete strategies for educators and policymakers on how to apply these findings to enhance academic achievement through motivational strategies.

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
