

Review of: "Clinical Audit: Oxygen Prescription with Target Saturations in Post Anesthesia Care Unit"

The authors address an important topic: Oxygen prescription with target saturations in post-anesthesia care is essential to avoid hypoxia on the one hand and hyperoxemia on the other (the latter should be included in both the introduction and discussion as increasing evidence for the risk and adverse effects of overtreatment with oxygen in various circumstances has been published in recent years).

The patient number is rather low, and data presentation should be improved: either text or tables should be used, but duplicity should be avoided.

The manuscript should be reviewed critically, as many formulations are unclear and make the text rather difficult to read.

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
