- 1. The subject was 10-19 years old. It included the period of child and adolescent. Sometimes the author used the child, sometimes the authors used the adolescent, please make consistent.
- 2. The sample size calculation showed that the research needed 650 subjects. However, the result only included the 624 subjects. Were the subjects enough?
- 3. How to check the neck circumstance? Please described the measure process.
- 4. The age groups were divided 10-14, 15-16, and 17-19 years old. Why did the age group separate?
- 5. In the line 3 of the definition section, "fasting plasma levels" was showed, but there was no data? please make sure.

 And it showed the "HDL-cholesterol <40". Why didn't the normal range of the HDL divide by gender?
- 6. There were many different values showed in the results section and tables. Please confirm. For example, about the underweight of the stage of adolescence, the χ^2 test was 9.64 in the table 1, however, the χ^2 test was 6.64 in the result section of the manuscript. About the overweight of the BMI-for-age, the p value, OR, and 95% CI were 0.32, 1.50, and 0.67, 3.32 in the result section of the manuscript, however, the values were 0.34, 0.67, 0.30, 1.49 in the table 1.
