

Review of: "The Discontinuity of the Virtual Toward the Non-Living and the Living"

The author of "The Discontinuity..." raises a central question that, in my view, requires much more thought and argument. She gives it that from a philosophical point of view. This reviewer's sense of the article is that it is well worth further work, especially on its language. Unfortunately, the quality of English is insufficiently high to allow for the clarity of expression required in discussing such a difficult topic. I would strongly suggest that it be revised in the company of a native speaker of the language, a friend or colleague who is willing to sit down with the author, point out the problems, and assist her with word choice, syntax, idiomatic expressions--and above all, with ways of saying what she wants to say in simpler language. Those who need to read the article most are those who will be unlikely to have the patience to struggle with difficult philosophical language. In short, my advice is this: don't give up!
