A standardized rating scale developed by D'Agostino et al in 2008, which is a gender-specific classification system used to estimate the 10-year risk of cardiovascular disease (CVD). This estimation takes into consideration of an individual's gender, age, smoking history, treatment for blood pressure, as well as systolic blood pressure, total cholesterol and high-density lipoprotein (HDL) cholesterol levels.
