Thank you for giving me the opportunity to review this manuscript. The article investigates the role of sociodemographic factors, contact with nature and Perception of biodiversity in Wildlife product consumption. The paper contributes to the literature, bringing important variables and helping to direct conservation policies, especially those that involve the participation of the local population. I found the article well-written. I'm not proposing big changes, but I have some suggestions that might clarify some concepts or ideas:

- Put in the introduction a brief definition of "connection to nature" and "perception of biodiversity"
- "WPC is often considered an indication of species extinction risk." Reference this
- "However, well-known pollution and poisons are often thought as the dominant opportunity to biodiversity." Reference this
- In the discussion it would be important to dedicate more text to discuss the results of this specific study, hypotheses 1, 2 and 3 have been confirmed but hypothesis 4 has not. It is very important to talk about studies in other countries, as you have done. But it is also important that you put possible explanations for the results in the specific context of Vietnam.
