Because there is no accompanying novel research, in my opinion it needs restructuring. My suggestions are:

- 1. a descriptive, literature review of the consequences of ADHD in females.
- 2. the article (in shortened form) could form the introduction section of the next research to be conducted (described in the Conclusion).
- 3. to re-format the article as an opinion piece, and dispense with the format of introduction, methods, results, discussion and conclusion. The Discussion section does not appear much different from the Introduction section. It is usual to discuss the results, but of course there are no results to discuss.

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
