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Potential competing interests: No potential competing interests to declare.

This study need several amendments based on several factors:

- 1. Sample size: Authors should described how they get the sample size since n=56 cases were quite small for the study.
- 2. Inclusion and exclusion criteria were not mentioned in the methodology section
- 3. How the authors confirmed each cases? Is it just simply by observations of the lesions? For scientific research like this, authors should confirm all cases by valid, reliable diagnostic techniques, not simply just by observation. Add pictures which represents the cases to convince reviewers and readers.
- 4. Authors should have used quantitative analysis to make the data reliable to report the results. Using just a simple percentage is not convincing. Authors should have used more reliable statistical analysis with p-value to report the result.
- 5. I don't see the importance of the questionnaires when there were no associations made between all the dependent & independent variables. Please use a proper, suitable analysis to determine for associations between both variables
- 6. In Table 3, authors mentioned about disease causing disability. It is not clear what does the authors mean, what kind of disability? it is not mentioned anywhere in the main text.

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
